an infinity spa framed by recessed fire panels, and a luxurious cabana with all the comforts of home, it's not surprising the family is doing a lot more living outside.

The cabana is the apex of this alfresco living space. The open-beam, solid-roof structure houses a living area anchored by a fire-place with a large television mounted above the mantel. Just steps away is a dining area and an L-shaped outdoor kitchen with ample prep and serving space, and built-in grill, refrigerator, ice maker and sink.

The dark-stained, exposed beams in the ceiling add contrast to the light earth tones used in the granite counters, limestone flooring, and fireplace and island finishes. Fountains, pottery and a stunning landscape design with specimen trees and plants, complete the space.
